

Principal Report for TPSA **3/11/2020**

1. Infrastructure update

- Kinder Mural – THS students have started pencilling out the mural in Kinder. Painting will commence on Friday and continue Mondays and Fridays until completed.
- Loose Parts shed has now been installed. Cleaning out of old items under EC deck and transferring materials to the new shed will occur over the next few weeks.
- Megan Tubb and students have planted out the new EC garden bed in the EC Entrance.
- New retaining wall near carpark / office is behind schedule. Hopefully to be completed by end of week 5. Remediation works will be carried out on the pathway into Play West and with the plantings that were removed from that area.
- Embankment work between Channel Hwy and Play West completed last week – valerian plant removal to follow up on work done last year in consultation with TEN.
- Installation of new bins (metal frame and bin inside – same as on oval) in the playground to occur before the end of 2020: general waste in EC, Quad and Play West. Red-cycle in Quad.
- Installation of new Access Carpark in visitor carpark to be completed in the next few weeks – first parking spot next to drop and pick up zone.
- Ongoing issues with children pushing sticks and other objects into the master-keyed padlocks / key holes in EC area. Each call out costs the school in excess of \$150.
- Installation of new Playground markings will occur in the next few weeks: Snakes and ladders & Hopscotch in ECE area (under shade sail) and chess board in quadrangle.
